NOTICE FOR WALK IN INTERVIEW

1) Name of the Post: Scientist D(Medical): Vacancy: 01(one) Unreserved Essential qualifications: Post Graduation in (MD/MS) with 05yrs R & D/ teaching experience or PG/ Diploma in Medical subjects with 06 yrs R & D/ teaching experience from recognized University **OR**

MBBS Degree recognized by MCI or equivalent degree from recognized University with 08yrs R & D/ teaching experience in medical subjects after MBBS Degree. Preferences will also be given to candidates having experience in Public Health/ Medicine from recognized University.

Desirable qualifications:

- Additional Post Doctoral research / teaching experience in medical subjects of recognized Institute
- 2) Knowledge of Computer Applications or Business Intelligence Tools/ Data Management.

Age limit: Not exceeding 45yrs (relaxable for SC/ST/OBC) candidates in accordance with Govt. of India Rules. **Retired physically fit person's upto the age of 65yrs** having the above essential qualifications may also be considered at the discretion of Selection Committee.

Salary: Fixed Rs 60000.00(Rupees Sixty Thousand) only.

2) Technical Assistant(Statistician): 01 nos(unreserved)

Essential qualifications: Three years Graduate Degree in Mathematics/ Statistics from a recognized University with 05 yrs of experience **OR**
