NOTIFICATION


A Casualty Assessment Committee (CAC) has been constituted with the following members under Adverse Monitoring Centre (AMC)/ Pharmacovigilance Center in Agartala Govt. Medical College & G.B. Pant Hospital for a period of 3(three) years from the date of issue of this Notification to establish a casual relationship between the Adverse events and Drugs of the reported cases:

1. Dr. Debasis Ray, Assoc. Prof., Pharmacology, AGMC - Chairman
2. Dr. Biplab Nath, Assoc. Prof., ENT, AMC - Member
3. Dr. Santa Sutradhar, (MD, Pharmacology) - Member.

The Terms of reference for CAC as per Secretary cum Scientific Director of India Pharmacopoeia Commission is as follows :

- Shall be responsible for casualty assessment of each Adverse Event/Case reported from their respective AMC/Peripheral Hospitals.
- The CAC shall meet at least twice in a month to do the casualty of each Adverse Event/Case reported from their AMC/Peripheral Hospitals.
- After the casualty assessment, Coordinator and Technical Associate shall be responsible to submit the reports to NCC - PvPI and in case of Serious Adverse Events (SAE) not later than 15 days.
- Tenure of the CAC shall be for a period of 3 years.
